

FIST AND MOUTH CONTEST COMPANY

Dues: Article V

The club, by 100% (one hundred percent) vote of those present at any REGULAR meeting, may levy upon the general membership such dues or assessments as shall be deemed necessary for the business of the organization. Non-payment of such dues or assessments will be cause for expulsion from the club within the discretion of the membership.

Membership Assistance: Article VI

The club, through designated Interference, Public Relations, and Operating Committees will provide technical advice to members concerning equipment design and operation to assist in frequency observance, clean signals, uniform practice, courteous on the air operating practices, and absence of spurious radiations from club member stations. The club shall also maintain a program to foster and guide public relations.

Amendments: Article VII

This constitution or the By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the total membership. Proposals for amendments shall be submitted in writing at a regular meeting and shall be voted on at the next following regular meeting, provided all members have been notified by mail of the intent to amend the constitution or by-laws at said meeting.
